  - Environment for multiple countries and areas by defining the minimum set of requirements
  - Towards sustainable distance learning environment by managing the environment by each site staff
- Distance learning environment through the Internet

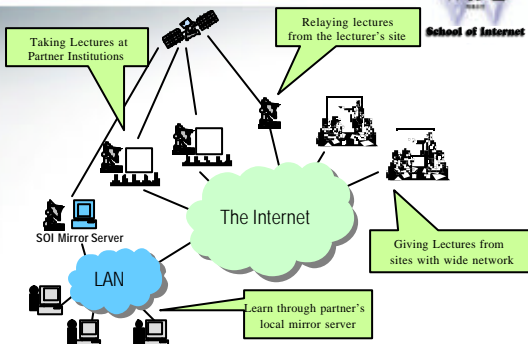
- Challenges

## Satellite communication as the infrastructure



- Satellite infrastructure can be build anywhere
- Definition of minimum environment will be easier with the spot building of the infrastructure
- In theory, 3 satellite can cover the world, and 1 satellite enables us to build our environment to wide area
- It has multicast function, so that variable lecture can be delivered to multiple sites
- Receive only satellite antenna does not cost much
  - Money, Getting the license
- Combination of satellite communication and existing terrestrial Internet infrastructure

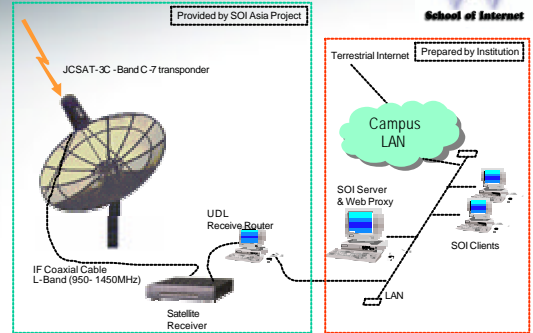

  - Better method for SOI Server installation

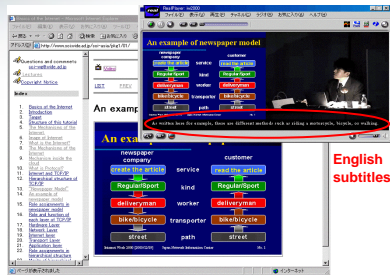
